

Highway 51 Grading Near Biggar



DESCRIPTION

The Ministry of Highways plans to continue to reconstruct the subgrade of about 24.5 km on Highway 51 near Biggar. This grading project also includes construction of various auxiliary roads and replacing culverts within the project area. This two-year project started in 2025, with roadwork paused over the winter. At the completion of this project, the road surface will be gravel. A separate contract will be tendered to complete paving.

The estimated cost of this capital project is \$15.9 million.

Roadwork expected to resume: April 2026



TRAFFIC ACCOMMODATION


You can expect delays and disruptions along Highway 51 with one way traffic and speeds reduced to 60 km/h. When construction occurs on the auxiliary roads, detours will be in place. Traffic may be stopped for up to 20 minutes.

Drivers can expect flaggers, automated speed enforcement signs, and electronic message boards. The ministry thanks motorists for their patience as these improvements occur and can check the Highway Hotline for updates.
